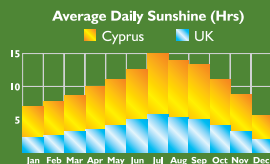
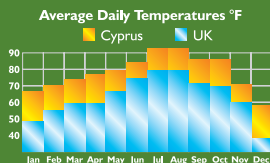
Cyprus - the island of love

Many areas are completely unspoiled and there is an abundance of wildlife and history to explore and encounter.

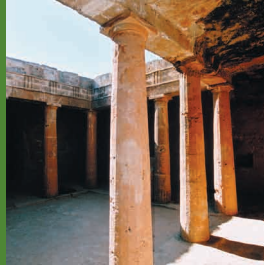
Cyprus offers so much to the visitor whatever their requirements. Walking tours, cycling trips, skiing, golf, scuba diving or lazing on a beach; there is almost no end to what you can do.

With its neolithic dwellings, the Ancient Greeks, the Romans and the Crusaders have all touched Cyprus throughout its nine thousand year history to create this unique, fascinating and captivating island.



Climate

With an average of 320 days of sunshine a year and temperate winters with little rainfall, especially compared to the UK, Cyprus offers the opportunity for year-round outdoor activities.



Mandria Village

Only 7km from the airport and boasting a beautiful, unspoilt coastline and beaches, Mandria is a peaceful, rural village with two tavernas, a shop, a bakery and a bank. The gentle pace of life is palpable.

Paphos Town

Head 14km west into Paphos, and you can experience both the modern and ancient culture of this historic town. The numerous shops, bars, tavernas and the nightlife, especially round the harbour in Kato Paphos, should satisfy any holiday need especially the culture vultures!

Further north takes you to the resort of Coral Bay and beyond, to the protected landscapes of the Akamas Peninsula and the Baths of Aphrodite.

Troodos Mountains

Mount Olympus peaks this mountain range of quaint villages, stunning views and skiing opportunities. A visit here is a must.

Car Hire

Although you are not far from anywhere in Cyprus, car or jeep hire is essential to make the most of your stay. Driving is on the left and all signs are in English. In the unlikely event that you get lost, anyone will be happy to help, such is the friendly nature of the Cypriot people.



Villa Miya

New this season and finished to a luxurious standard, Villa Miya is roomy, comfortable, fully air-conditioned and has a large private pool.



Double patio doors lead out onto the large, paved poolside area housing a table and chairs, parasols, and sun loungers for six. The pool itself is 8m x 4m, features Roman steps for ease of entry and exit, and varies in depth from 1 to 2 metres. A perfect and relaxing place to spend the whole day soaking up the rays of the Cypriot sun.



The shaded, porched front door opens into a spacious entrance hall with toilet and washroom. This leads to a large, open plan living and dining area which occupies most of the ground floor. To the right, the well fitted kitchen with its granite worktops has all the modern appliances including dishwasher and washing machine and conveniently, a door which leads to the off-street parking - very useful for the shopping!

The living room is equipped with a TV, Sky Decoder, DVD player and CD music system for your entertainment. There is a feature fireplace for those cosy intimate evenings and for those who like the warmth, the air-conditioning also doubles as central heating.

There is comfortable seating for all in the lounge area and a dining table and chairs for six.

The rest of the garden features traditional, Mediterranean flowering shrubs to all borders. A BBQ is also provided for your alfresco dining pleasure.

Back inside, the broad, marble staircase with its glass block window leads to the three upstairs bedrooms. The master bedroom with its kingsize bed also has a spacious mosaic-tiled shower room with toilet, bidet and washbasin accessed through the en-suite dressing room as well as having a balcony over-looking the pool and garden.

The two twin bedrooms share a front aspect with views to the sea, one having a balcony. These rooms are served by a large, mosaic-tiled bathroom which includes a bath, overhead shower, toilet and washbasin. All bedrooms feature fitted wardrobes.

The website has a plan of the villa or we can provide one to you upon request.

Bath & poolside towels and linen are included as is pool and villa cleaning on a weekly basis. You will also receive a free welcome pack upon arrival.

Villa Miya is a no smoking villa and so we respectfully request our guests to smoke outside.



The Golf Experience

Using Villa Miya as your base, there are currently three excellent golf courses from which to choose and more under construction.



Tsada is the longest established. Situated 15km north-east of Paphos, this par 72 course is 550m above sea level ensuring beautiful views and cool breezes. Course length is 6,060m.

Drive seven minutes east from the villa and you will arrive at the par 74 course of **Secret Valley**, set amongst natural rock formations and trees. Course length is 5,904m

Just next door is the award winning, par 71 course of **Aphrodite Hills**. Built on two plateaux separated by a ravine, the course has to be seen to be believed. Course length is 6,229m.

All of these courses offer wonderful playing experiences as well as first class facilities and the climate of Cyprus makes year-round golf a viable and attractive alternative to playing in the rain-soaked UK!
